## **Day 1, Thursday 29 may**

### *Rules*

Welcome to the 11<sup>th</sup> Segny-Monte Carlo Rally. We have tried to make this rally a simple one, so that you have plenty of time to enjoy yourselves. But, it is nevertheless a competition and therefore there are some rules.

Each day counts as a stage in determining the winner of this year's rally. For every stage, any team can earn a maximum of 50 points. It will be clear from the instructions how you can win points. You can only win points by carrying out the assignments. You can only lose points by opening panic envelopes or by being late (at the beginning as well as at the end of a stage!). The team with the most points will win the stage. At the end of the stage, teams will be given points according to their position (from winners to losers:) 10, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Ties are possible.

The winner of this year's rally will be the team with the most points after the three stages. In case of a tie for the first and second place, a tie breaker question will be posed during the banquet on the last evening. The winning team will have the honor, the pleasure and the duty to organize next year's rally.

If at any moment during the rally there is a disagreement about points, the organizer's decision will be final. And just like in a football game, the organizers are always right, even if they were factually wrong.

Finally, we count on you to help any team that you see who are in trouble. Please drive very carefully.

9.30	Briefing session on the car park at CERN, in front of the flags.
10.00	Drive to Villard-de-Lans, via autoroute to Grenoble, take direction Lyon in Grenoble, exit 14 immediately after Grenoble, turn left over the autoroute, then left again N552 to Grenoble, then right onto the D531. Or follow the map. Park on any of the big car parks in Villard-de-Lans and walk to the restaurant.
